

Winter Wheat Harvested by State



Oregon Wheat Crop Report

August Status: Oregon Wheat

Golden fields of grain as the crop has reached maturity in most of the state and harvest has moved past the midway point.

The first weekly crop quality report is now available, but is based on a very limited number of samples so should not yet be used to assess the full crop quality. Representative data on the Pacific Northwest wheat crop is collected during harvest each year, with samples consistently analyzed by the Wheat Marketing Center for the soft white wheat crop.



Nebraska Wheat Crop Report

District 1 Report

Harvest across the state is approximately 92% complete.

In District 1, progress continues steadily, with around 85% of the area harvested.

Recent rainfall over a few days and high humidity caused harvest delays, pushing start times later into the afternoon, making for shorter days.

Yields are averaging between 30 and 50 bushels per acre. Similar to District 2, field areas with thinner stands are experiencing increased Sawfly pressure. Despite this, overall quality remains strong, with protein levels ranging from 12% to 14%.
